- 1 Disability is a mismatch between person & environment
 - Participation challenges are not exclusively due to personal characteristics
 - The social environment can be a big barrier to participation
- 2 Assess how the social environment impacts participation
 - What are the attitudes of peers and school staff towards disability?
 - Do school policies and procedures support social participation of all students?
 - * Include the student with disabilities' view of their social environment
- 3 Social environmental barriers are malleable...address them!
 - Promote inclusion by conducting peer awareness education
 - Advocate for inclusive school practices and opportunities for social participation

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
